Ishigaki Island Stalactite Cave

In ancient times, this was the sea floor. The movement of the earth's crust over many years tells the splendor of the stalactites.

- The growth of the stalactites is relatively fast at 1 mm every three years
- The average temperature inside the caves is 23°C, with humidity of 90% or more.



The Lake of Longevity

The crystal clear spring leaves a profound impression. It makes the white stalactites appear even more beautiful.



Totoro Stalactite

This is said to resemble Totoro, and the name has stuck. It's a popular spot for taking a commemorative photo.



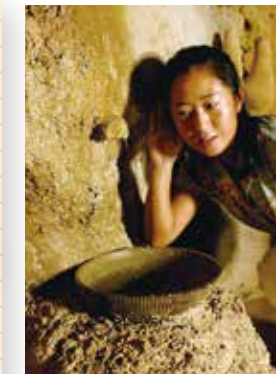
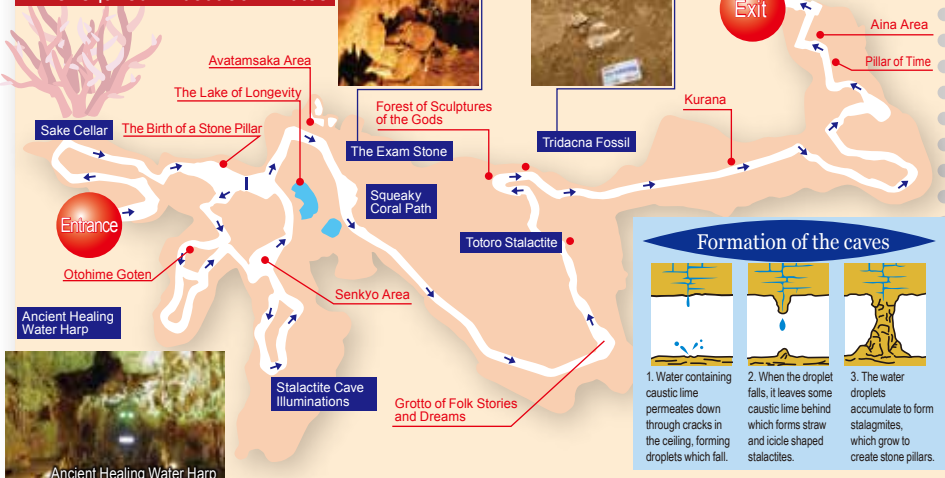
Seashell Fossil

This fossil shows that this was under the sea in ancient times. There are various fossils in the cave, and it's fun to search for them.

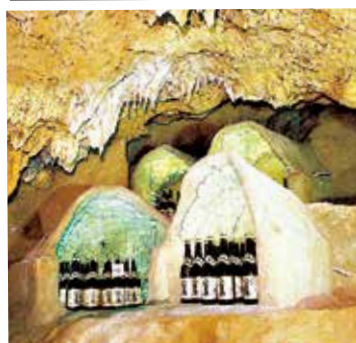

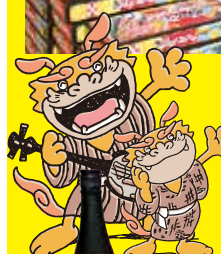
